Symbiosis Law School conducted *Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET)* 2014 on May 3, 2014 all over India for admission in Law Program for Pune and Noida Campus. Like the last year, this year also SET -Law has not thrown any surprises to the aspirants. The overall paper structure was similar to that of the last year's paper. The level of difficulty of the questions was moderate.

There were total 150 questions which were supposed to be done in 150 minutes. The exam comprised of 5 sections - Logical Reasoning, Legal Reasoning, Analytical Reasoning, Reading Comprehension and General Knowledge. Each question carried 1 mark and there was no negative marking for wrong answer.

A detailed analysis of each section is given below:

Logical Reasoning

The questions in this section were based on the basic logics and those who would have prepared for this section well in advance would have been easily able to crack most of the questions. With the total number of 30 questions, the level of difficulty would be rated as easy to moderate.

Legal Reasoning

This section was the most critical one with the questions coming from Legal Reasoning and Legal Knowledge. There were around 30 questions and

those who prepared with full concentration could have attempted around 23-25 questions. The difficult part in Legal Reasoning was from Contracts, followed by Criminal Law, and Constitutional Law. However, the questions in Legal Knowledge were from Constitutional Law and Criminal Law. The level of difficulty could be rated as moderate.

Analytical Reasoning

Students rated this as the easiest section. With total of 30 questions, a score of around 22-25 could be easily achieved. There were few questions from Verbal Logical part as well.

- an excerpt of Jawaharlal Nehru's interview, another two excerpts from Sunday Times. The difficulty faced was in the passage which was based on a court's judgment. We would rate this section as moderate.

General Knowledge

As we have already been guiding our students, GK comprised of two parts – Static GK and Current GK. There were total of 30 questions and difficulty level could be rated from easy to moderate.
